## **Cats and Dogs Ultra Moist Hooking Pellets**

**Summer is here but the fish can still be stand offish because of the changeable weather. But here's a trick that will have you experiencing fewer line bites and foul-hooked fish - and putting more fish in the net.**

If you start feeding a small number of our ready to use soft feed pellets in either 2.5 or 4.5mm pellets this seems to attract fish into your target area.

The answer is to feed what you also have on the hook in very small numbers, so there are fewer large pellets in the water, which means that the fish become more interested in your hook bait. And our 6mm Ultra Moist Hooking Pellets are brilliant for this. All you have to do is open the tub and

use them, but a quick tip, if it is really hot put a small amount of pellets into another container and cover with water to stop them drying out.

As I said earlier, the beauty of this idea is that you feed very small amounts of what you are using on the hook and carp get caught out by this neat little idea time after time.

Remember our soft feed pellets are also designed to be used with the pellet/bagging waggle and will form around the cage and explode into a cloud of falling pellets once the float hits the water.
